

Low Street Public Realm Improvements

24th February to 8th August 2025

Information for Businesses and Residents

On Monday 24th February, work will start to improve the public realm along the east side of Low Street. The project, which we are delivering in partnership with Sherburn-In-Elmet Town Council, consists of upgrading all surfacing using higher quality materials and creating a brand-new town centre map, real-time bus information and new seating. The project aims to improve the appearance of the town centre from the Swan Pub down to Starkey's Butcher.

The project is funded by the UK Shared Prosperity Fund, which we administer, and the Programme for Growth, established by the former district council.

Work will start on site on Monday 24th February and is due for completion on Friday 8th August 2025. The work will be completed in phases to minimise disruption in the town.
